





College of Child & Youth Nurses - NZNO Honorary Life Membership

Purpose:

Honorary life membership maybe presented to any member or ex-member of the College of Child & Youth, NZNO from time to time in recognition of their contribution to child and youth nursing in New Zealand (NZ).

Criteria:

The nominee must be a current or past CCYN member who has/ had a commitment to CCYN and who has made a significant contribution to the national work of CCYN.

Specifics of the Honorary Membership:

- Successful nominees will receive free lifetime membership, including free registration to the CCYN Bi-Annual Symposium.
- Flights from anywhere in NZ to attend the AGM in person, where they will be awarded their honorary membership.

Nominations:

- 1. A nominator must provide a brief outline of the:
 - Nominee's contribution to CCYN;
 - nominee's contribution to child & youth nursing in NZ, including a brief career history; and
 - the region of NZ the nominee lives/ works.
- 2. The process includes:
 - Self-nominations will NOT be accepted, the nominee must be nominated by someone else.
 - Closing dates for nominations annually will be one month before the AGM of the CCYN committee.
 - a. Nominations for the awards are to be forwarded to the CCYN Secretary in MS Word format secretary.ccyn@gmail.com
 - Approval of the nominee does not have to be sought
 - The CCYN national committee decides annually on the awards.
 - b. All recipients will be listed on the CCYN website.
