



## **NZ College of Critical Care Nurses (NZCCCN) Elections for 2022**

***We are seeking nominations for 1 position in the Northern Region, 1 position in the MidSouth region, 1 position in the Southern region and 1 position in the Central region.***

**Nominations close at 5pm on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022**

### **Rules for Election**

The current NZ College of Critical Care Nurses rules state:

- The National Committee shall consist of eight (8) elected people.
- Two representatives will be elected from each of Northern, Midland and Central regions and one each from MidSouth and Southern regions.
- The term of office shall be for two (2) years with the right of re-election for a further two (2) years, or for three (3) years with the right of re-election for a further three (3) years. Members shall be eligible for re- election after a break of two years.

### **Regions**

The NZCCCN are represented by five regions:

- **NORTHERN:** Auckland and Northland
- **MIDLAND:** Gisborne, Hawke's Bay, Rotorua, Tauranga, Waikato and Whakatane.
- **CENTRAL:** Blenheim, Nelson, New Plymouth, Palmerston North, Wairarapa, Wanganui and Wellington
- **MIDSOUTH:** Ashburton, Canterbury, Timaru and West Coast.
- **SOUTHERN:** Otago and Southland

### **The current NZCCCN committee consists of:**

1. 5 members who are part way through their term and are remaining on the committee for 2022:
  - Rachel Yong – Northern region
  - David Aveyard – Midland region
  - Rachel Atkin – Midland region
  - Lara Millar – Central region
  - Tania Mitchell – Central region – re-standing for second term
2. 1 member who was seconded and wishing to be nominated and stay on as a committee member
  - Diane Pollard – MidSouth region
3. 2 members who are standing down from the committee in 2022:
  - Steve Kirby – Northern Region
  - Renee Holland – Southern region

Nominees should be current members of NZCCCN. Only members in the region can nominate and vote for representatives. E.g. Only the Midland Region can nominate and vote for a representative for their region. Nominations close at 5pm on 1 April 2022. Nominees will be contacted by NZNO shortly after this date. A postal or online ballot will be required if there is more than one nominee for the region. Elections will be completed by 5pm on 13<sup>th</sup> May 2022.
