



NZ College of Critical Care Nurses (NZCCCN) Elections for 2023

We are seeking nominations for 1 position in the Central Region, 1 position in the Northern region.

Nominations close at 5pm on 15 September 2023

Rules for Election

The current NZ College of Critical Care Nurses rules state:

- The National Committee shall consist of eight (8) elected people.
- Two representatives will be elected from each of Northern, Midland and Central regions and one each from MidSouth and Southern regions.
- The term of office shall be for two (2) years with the right of re-election for a further two (2) years, or for three (3) years with the right of re-election for a further three (3) years. Members shall be eligible for re- election after a break of two years.

Regions

The NZCCCN are represented by five regions:

- NORTHERN: Auckland and Northland
- MIDLAND: Gisborne, Rotorua, Tauranga, Waikato and Whakatane.
- CENTRAL: Blenheim, Nelson, New Plymouth, Palmerston North, Wairarapa, Hawke's Bay, Wanganui and Wellington.
- MIDSOUTH: Ashburton, Canterbury, Timaru and West Coast.
- SOUTHERN: Otago and Southland

The current NZCCCN committee consists of:

- 6 members who are part way through their term and are remaining on the committee for 2023:
 - Rachel Yong Northern region
 - David Aveyard Midland region
 - Rachel Atkin Midland region
 - Tania Mitchell Central region
 - Diane Pollard MidSouth region
 - Alicia Osland Southern region
- 2. 2 members who were seconded and wishing to be nominated and stay on as a committee member.
 - Richard Ferreira Northern region
 - Nayda Heays Central region (Te Runanga rep)

Nominees should be current members of NZCCCN. Only members in the region can nominate and vote for representatives. E.g., Only the Midland Region can nominate and vote for a representative for their region. Nominations close at 5pm on 15 September 2023. Nominees will be contacted by NZNO shortly after this date. A postal or online ballot will be required if there is more than one nominee for the region. Elections will be completed by 5pm on 8 November 2023.
