

Memorandum of Understanding

Between

New Zealand College of Critical Care Nurses (NZCCCN)

&

New Zealand Critical Care Outreach Nurses

Purpose: to develop a strategic alliance between the NZCCCN and the New Zealand Critical Care Outreach Nurses.

Objective: to work in collaboration on issues affecting the care of in hospital patients requiring Critical Care Outreach Nursing and care provided by Critical Care Outreach teams in New Zealand.

Parties:

New Zealand College of Critical Care Nurses (NZCCCN) New Zealand College of Critical Care Nurses (NZCCCN) is a college of the New Zealand Nurses Organisation. It provides the collective voice for nurses in New Zealand with an interest in the specialty area of critical care. The NZCCCN aims include: to promote critical care nursing and increase the profile of critical care nurses; to disseminate standards of practice and standards for education in critical care nursing; to provide a communications network for all members and disseminate information on relevant issues; to encourage and support research into critical care nursing; to liaise with appropriate authorities on social, health, education and other issues relevant to critical care nursing and to communicate and liaises with international Critical Care organisations.

Time and review of MOU

The MOU will commence on the date it is signed by both parties. A joint review will take place 24 months after the signing.
