Type 2 Diabetes in Youth and Emerging Adults: Godzilla vs Kung Fu Panda

About the Speakers:

Priya Joseph is a Diabetes Clinical Nurse Specialist working with the Diabetes youth and young adult team at the Waikato Regional Diabetes Service. She has special interest in the diabetes management of young adults and recently completed a dissertation project on Type 2 Diabetes in youth. Priya will present on her project which aimed to examine existing research on the rate of progression of complications among youth with Type 2 Diabetes, and analyse the effectiveness of current interventions. The research identifies the need for New Zealand-based studies and guidelines to identify safe, acceptable, culturally appropriate, and age-specific interventions to effectively manage youth with Type 2 Diabetes.

Dr Sasini Wijyaratna has worked as a Diabetes Physician at ADHB for the past 5 years, working at the Auckland Diabetes Centre and National Women's Health. She is a part of the Young Adults Clinic multidisciplinary team, where the increasing number of young people with type 2 diabetes has become very apparent. Sasini's presentation will focus on the clinical complications, risk-factors, and healthcare service use of this growing population in the Auckland region, including the impact of socioeconomic deprivation.
