Dr Joanna McClintock (DipClinPsych) is a clinical psychologist and has worked in diabetes care for 15 years at Waikato District Health Board, covering paediatrics through to young adults. She also works for Rural Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services. Jo is a strong advocate for a multidisciplinary approach to diabetes care and the promotion of resiliency.

Dr Rikki Thompson (PGDipClinPsych) is a clinical psychologist working for the Canterbury District Health Board in both the adult Diabetes and Specialist Mental Health Services. Rikki believes in empowering patients to improve their own diabetes self-care by supporting them to identify, understand, and overcome their unique barriers.

Lisa Hoyle (DipHealthPsych) is a health psychologist at Counties Manukau District Health Board working in both the Diabetes and Renal Services. She is also Acting Professional Leader – Psychology for Counties Manukau DHB. Lisa is dedicated to improving outcomes for those living with diabetes; particularly reducing inequities, complications and improving mental wellbeing.
