



## CENNZ Awards

### AWARDS DETAILS

#### **Foundation Award**

This award acknowledges the individual emergency nurse who has enhanced the profile of and/or shown excellence in Emergency Nursing in New Zealand.

#### **General Award Criteria:**

- The nominee who may apply for this award is, any current full CENNZ<sup>NZNO</sup> member for 2 financial years consecutively. Non- members of CENNZ<sup>NZNO</sup> will be excluded.
- The nominee's nursing role is held within Aotearoa.

#### **Kirsty Morton Award**

Annual award in memory of Kristy Morton, a widely respected emergency nurse and triage course instructor who worked at Tauranga Hospital Emergency Department. Kirsty set high standards for herself and for others, and exemplified the qualities that all Emergency nurses aspire to. The award recognises a nurse who achieves a high standard while undertaking the New Zealand National Triage Course on behalf of the College of Emergency Nurses - NZNO.

It will be presented to a participant in the National Triage Course identified by the triage course coordinator and instructors as an outstanding student. Their selection will be based on their observation and assessment of all course participants.

#### **Specific Award Criteria**

- Successful completion of the Triage course
- Inclusive of all attendees of the National Triage course in the year proceeding AGM

#### **Advanced Emergency Nurses Network (AENN) Award**

In recognition of a nurse's contribution to advanced emergency nursing by the best contribution or presentation at AENN training days.

#### **General Award Criteria:**

- The nominee who may apply for this award is, any current full CENNZ<sup>NZNO</sup> member for 2 financial years consecutively. Non- members of CENNZ<sup>NZNO</sup> will be excluded.
- The nominee's nursing role is held within Aotearoa.

### **Novice Journal Article Award**

The purpose of this award is to acknowledge novice writers who have been published in the CENNZ<sup>NZNO</sup> journal. Requirements are first-time journal article publisher for the CENNZ<sup>NZNO</sup> journal.

### **Honorary Life Membership**

Honorary life membership may be bestowed from time to time to any member or ex-member of the College of Emergency Nurses New Zealand – NZNO in recognition of their contribution to emergency nursing in New Zealand. Such membership is rare and unusual.

Members will receive the benefit of full membership, journal access and is able to access all CENNZ<sup>NZNO</sup> awards.

### **Specific Award Criteria**

- A Personal and positive impact on Emergency nursing in New Zealand/Aotearoa
- Activities on a national and international level which has increased the status and public recognition for Emergency nurses in New Zealand
- Promotion of the work and aims of the College of Emergency Nurses New Zealand in a significant manner
- Involved in developing best practise guidelines and advancing emergency nursing in New Zealand through research.
