He Puawai Tapuhi Māori (Māori Nurses Education) Grant

Purpose

This grant is available to all full CENNZ members who identify as Māori to provide financial support towards education, training, and professional development opportunities.

The grant

This grant embodies the commitment of CENNZ to address, support and enhance the development of Tapuhi Māori. CENNZ is committed to the inclusion of tikanga Māori within Emergency nursing enhancing care for whanau, hapu, iwi accessing ED, while creating supportive team environments that are inclusive of the unique worldview of Tapuhi Māori. The CENNZ committee will review each application taking into consideration the aspiration to access professional development opportunities that will enhance cultural responsiveness of Emergency Nursing.

Inclusion criteria:

- Applicants must be a full and current CENNZ-NZNO member for approx. one year when applying.

Exclusion criteria:

- Funding will not be provided if the applicant has received a CENNZ-NZNO grant within the previous financial year.

Specifics of fund:

- To tautoko Māori nurses on their journey within Emergency nursing, CENNZ offers an education grant. Available to Nurses who identify as Māori and work within the Emergency Departments of Aotearoa.
- Ko wai au? We invite those that know their whakapapa to share with us their iwi and hapu affiliations if they are aware, in order to capture and acknowledge your whakapapa. In a short letter we ask the applicant to share with us your purakau (story) of what you would like to study and what your future aspirations may be.

Terms and Conditions for successful applicants.

- Depositing of any funds by the college member denotes acceptance of the following terms and conditions.
- Any funding given by CENNZ-NZNO to the applicant will be used strictly for the purpose for which it was granted. Course details and costs should be provided at time of application if possible.
- Sharing the knowledge gained with emergency nursing colleagues with acknowledgement of CENNZ funding is appreciated. Recipients are also encouraged to share their learning in the CENNZ journal.
