

## College of Emergency Nurses New Zealand – NZNO LEADERSHIP IN EMERGENCY NURSING GRANT

### Purpose:

This grant has been established by CENNZ to assist in the advancement of Emergency Nursing leadership. The intention of the grant is to support two experienced nurses per year to attend the approved course, see below. CENNZ acknowledges the role that nurse leader's play in supporting the College's mission of promoting excellence in emergency nursing.

### Course:

Emergency Nurse Leadership two day course held at Monash University, Melbourne

Course dates 31<sup>st</sup> October to 1<sup>st</sup> November 2019

### Inclusion:

- Applicants must have a full and current CENNZ – NZNO membership for the past two financial years.
- Applicants must have local endorsement from an identified nursing leader in their organization.
- Applicants are to supply a 500 word summary of how the above grant could benefit their advancing practice and leadership direction.

### Exclusion:

- Funding will not be provided to an applicant who has received CENNZ funding in the past financial year
- Funding under this grant has been nominated for the above mentioned course and cannot be used for an alternative educational option.

### Specifics of the fund:

- The decision to accept or decline an application is made by the CENNZ – NZNO national committee. The decision of the national committee is final.
- Applications should be made via the CENNZ website by interested members who meet the inclusion criteria
- CENNZ will cover the cost of the course fees plus airfares up to a cost of \$1500.00 per person. Additional costs will be the responsibility of the recipient.
- Applications for this course must be submitted by 30<sup>th</sup> June 2019
- The successful applicants will be listed in the subsequent Cennz online journal
- The successful applicants will be invited to present at the CENNZ annual conference

### Terms and Conditions for successful applicants

- Any funding given by CENNZ – NZNO to the applicant is to be used strictly for the purpose for which it was granted.
- Should the applicant not be able to undertake the course for which funding was awarded it is expected he/she will refund the full amount.
