- Nominations must be received two months prior to the AGM to enable consideration by the CENNZ-NZNO committee.

Requirements and processes:

- All nominations must be sent to the National Committee secretary
- Any member, group of members or region may nominate an individual for honorary life membership.

Honorary life membership will be awarded at the Annual General Meeting of CENNZ-NZNO.

Approval of the person being nominated does not have to be sought.
