



College of Emergency Nurses New Zealand (CENNZ) Membership Report 2022 Annual General Meeting

As of 1st October 2022, CENNZ-NZNO has 434 levied members and five (5) lifetime members as well as eight (8) foundation members. Membership is down from last year's total which sat at approximately 512 members at a similar time. Membership is ongoing and continues to accumulate right up until the next financial year therefore it is difficult to accurately predict the full year's membership until the end of March 2023.

CENNZ membership is spread throughout New Zealand in both rural and tertiary environments. This now also benefits the nurses based in Accident and Medical or Urgent Care environments.

Membership continues to be accepted for the following financial year from the 1st February. There is flexibility of maintaining current membership, a period of three months' extension into the next financial year. This is to enable members the time to complete the online registration process which is necessary every year along with a fee payment of \$25.00 and additional charge of \$5.00 if choosing to pay by credit card.

CENNZ provides networking from likeminded nurses and support the Emergency Nursing work environment by promoting excellence in development of Clinical Practice, Education & Research. We continue to encourage those who have yet to register to do so.
