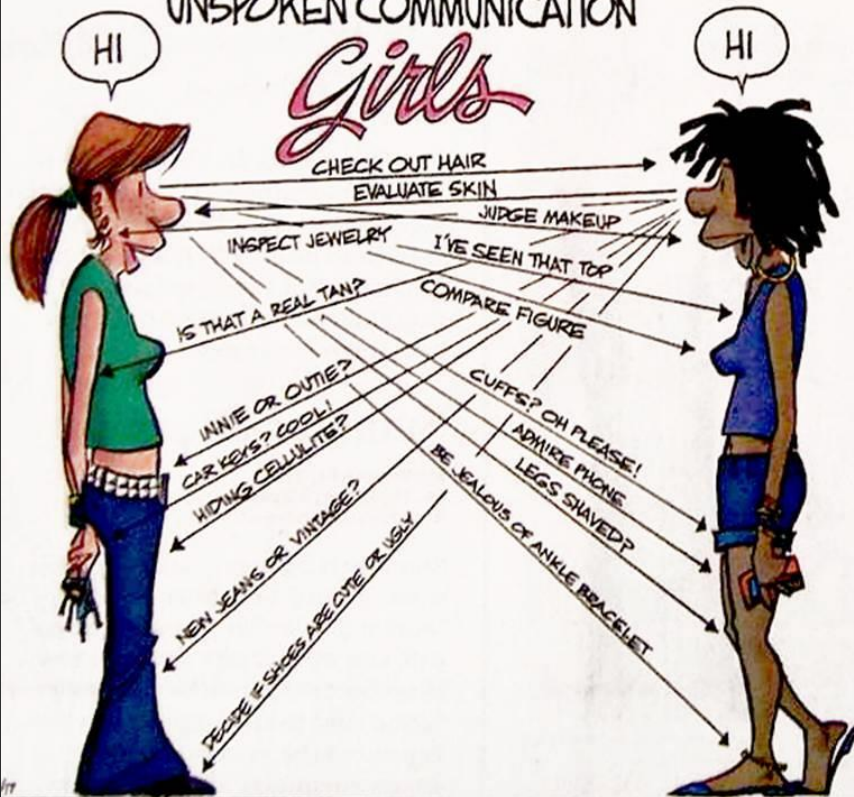

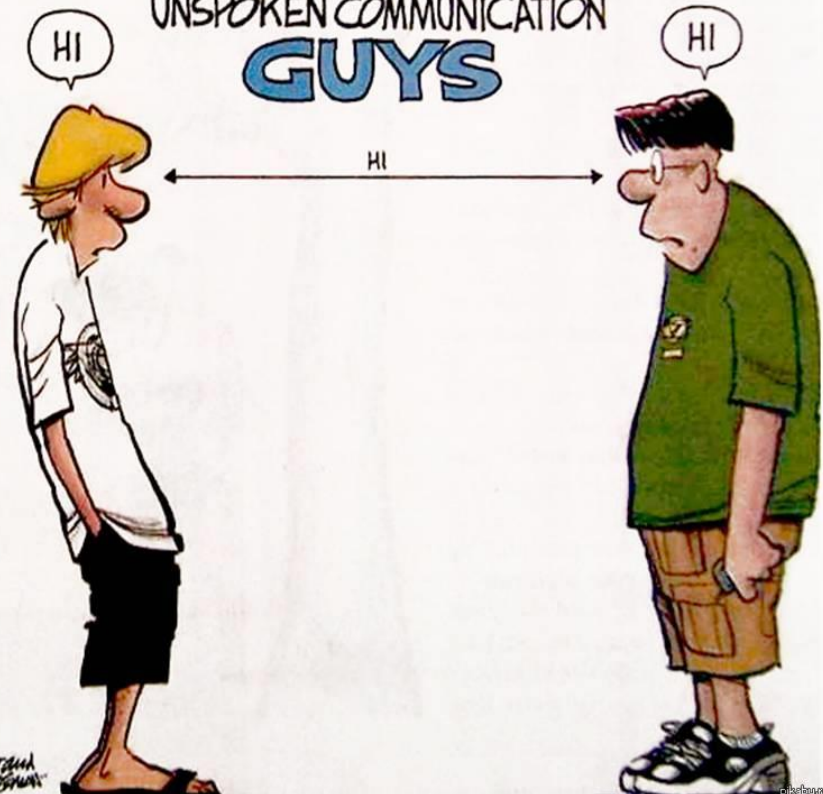

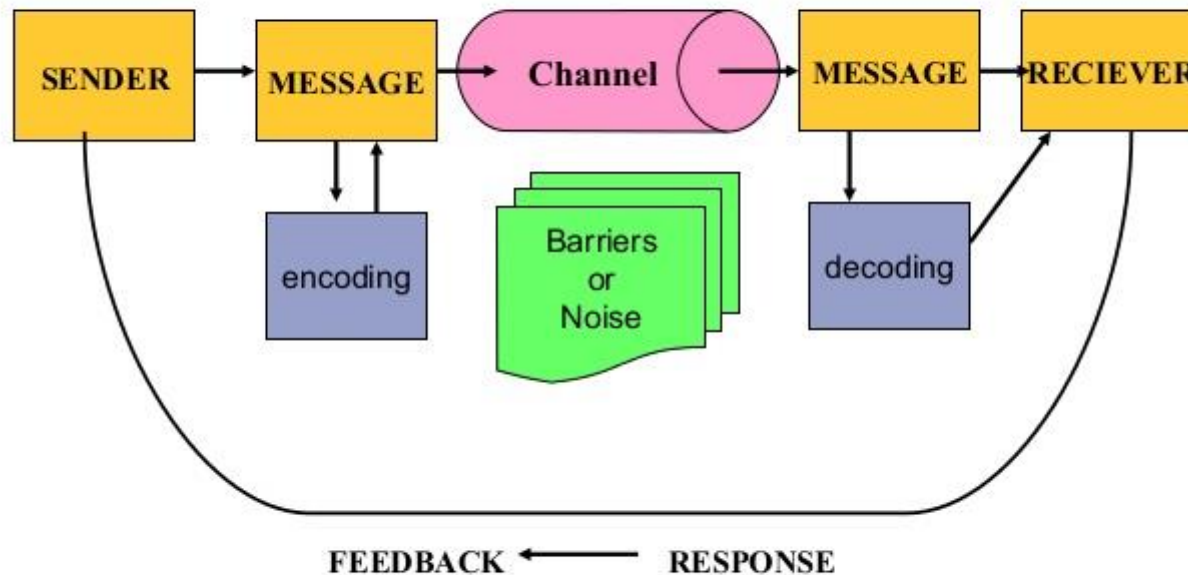

- Learning opportunities


Negative
