ABOUT THE COURSE:

The Emergency Nursing Paediatric Course was developed by the ENA (USA) to improve the care of the paediatric patient through international development and the identification of a standardized body of paediatric nursing knowledge. ENPC is a 1.5-day intensive course with a comprehensive manual, hands on skill stations and group discussions. The combined course utilises the use of compulsory online educational modules, face to face educational and skill station teaching and testing and taking the online multiple-choice examination post course. Results of the skill stations are given out at completion of the classroom activities and the final result is given out through ENA once the online examination is completed.

The Australian College of Emergency Nursing Ltd. will award 20 in-service hours to participants who attend the entire course regardless of their performance during testing. All participants will receive an in-service certificate, at the time of the course. The Provider Verification card will be issued by ENA once the examination has been successfully completed.
