Mental health biggest area that requires nurses. Also mentioned by Andrea and Emma General Medical Subsidy (GMS) - ENs can claim it who work in medical/general practice. Changes were made in 2014.

Regulations were changed so more health professionals can claim.

ACC, Nursing Council & MOH working on this-ENs cannot be treatment providers. ACC did not know Angela was working as a provider.

Jane will go to ACC with Angela's presentation GMC info and Sue's experiences. ACC visiting GP's to advise them. MOH don't agree with this, EN's should be doing wound care as can work to full S of P, but haven't been able to convince them. We will meet with ACC again. If there is a barrier for EN's you see in legislation put in submissions. RN is signing off on Wound care that EN's doing in GP. Supported into practice programme - EN's, NENZ's website closed for updating—want the supported into practice framework to go on this website

EN Fact Sheet – we need an update.

InteRai -

ENs are eligible to complete the training. Bottleneck of RNs wanting the training which has caused ENs not to complete the training as yet but is up to organization/facility to send them.

InteRai is incorporated into the CAP programme for IQN' nurses.

Maori workforce is increasing across the health spectre, although not as EN's. Maori students are often encouraged to do the Bachelor Nursing rather than Diploma in Enrolled Nursing. How can we promote enrolled nursing as a profession. How do we encourage youth to want to be EN's.

Aged Care- can do more in this area. Aged Residential Care document look at it. ? changed to enable more EN's to work in this area. Need to get rid of barriers that exist so employers can see and employ.

Improving Accuracy of Data – Talk to Claire about data. Data not same quality as RN data collected. NCNZ indicated they would run data for 2016 /2017 for EN's.

Sue Goodwin asked question re immunisation's off site- they cannot use Sue as is not an independent vaccinator. Hilary responded that if off site can be a vaccinator. Sue to email Jane re onsite and offsite and she will investigate. ? Nationwide or just your area.

Jane O'Malley leaves her position ?23rd February, no recruitment as yet into her position. Jane has been chief nurse for 7 years.

Memo Musa CEO NZNO	Updated re the ACC issue which was spoken about at November's meeting. Discussion on the marketing of ENs the value we add to the health system the continuation of care. Improvement of the health system includes enrolled nurses. ACC reneging on ENs as providers of wound care.
	Hilary suggests Memo sends a letter of support for ENs to the ACC. The ACT deliberatively excludes EN's. Would need a legislative change to include EN's. ACC need to visit sites to see what EN's do. Discussions with Claire Austin – Hilary outlined. Memo suggests acting quickly while changes are happening. A face to face meeting with ACC, Memo and EN Section in Wellington in early March 2018 Memo suggested that Suzanne pull together some examples of Jane's and Angela's and put together that Memo can sign off.
	Memo- last meeting? Enrolled nursing workforce data and ACE ACE Reference group – does not include EN's Met with Chai Chuah, Stephen Barclay, & Jane O'Malley re EN's being included in ACE.
