		Pam discussed with the Committee:  Nursing workforce  NCNZ projects –moving nursing forward –enabling  NCNZ as Regulatory Body has to go through formal consultation process. Never a quick fix to change some attitudes & ideas in sector.  Some limitations to NCNZ role.		
		Nursing workforce & data Pam updated us on this, e.g. shape standards, scope, guidelines with employers.

DHB's are the biggest employer of ENs in New Zealand. Large exit from work force in the future & Population/Demand. NOT NZNC role to organize nursing workforce.

NZNC looking at RN preparation and future needs:

Pam has a team of two others Craig Waterworth - Public health background; Jennifer Roberts, former EIT Head of Nursing School; working with her on the RN review.

- Suzanne mentioned that Wendy Blair, PNA, NZNO has/ completing doctorate on "Competencies"
- 2001 was the last RN review of SoP currently looking at rewriting this. March/April 2019 go back to council with draft standards, competences and state exam. Next ENS meeting NZNC may have ideas by then about what we need/want to change
- Focus on Education programs = preparation of new nurses.
- Thinking 10 years out, what's best practice? Clinical experience, preceptorship.
- NZNC will talk to education providers and students to get feedback.
- NZNC role as educator maybe required more in the future.
- Next ENS meeting NCNZ may have ideas by then about what we need/want to change
- EN section should be a key stakeholder in the RN Review Suzanne

NZNC getting better IT system so they can obtain better data:

- NZNC updating website so member can update/access address, ph numbers etc.
- User friendly. To improve communication, rebrand to fit today's needs.
- Currently paper base system used which is outdated.
- NZNC thinking about outsourcing verification document to identify international nursing qualification fits with NZ Health system.
- Move away from paper base credentials

Review of the HPCA act is going through Parliament at present

Discussion with Pam re Enrolled Nurses:

- DON's still not understanding the S o P of the Enrolled Nurse Suzanne
- EN's at Northland DHB have been told by DON that they cannot work in Acute areas as not in S o P.
- Enrolled Nurse Section would like to see Direction and Delegation removed from the current Enrolled Nurse S o P, due to the confusion and interpretation of it by RN's, DON'S and others. 2011 EN S o P was reviewed and rewritten.
- Pam workplans: S o P of RN 2001 (11years) since last reviewed, so priority.
- ENS o P should be an easier task.
- Enrolled Nurse committee offered to re write the S o P, removing the D&D and submit to NCNZ
- Dr Margaret Hughes talked to Pam in February 2018 re EN D&D.
- LPN's in Ontario –they have tasks of what EN can do

Enrolled Nurse Abstracts for Conference 2019 Discussion with Pam Re ACC: Pam fully aware of the implications for EN's.

- When the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act (HPCA) 2003 had to make changes to the other Acts. The words "General Nursing"
- Changing the wording can be difficult, as many outcomes are determined by legislation, and changes need to fit with this.
- The broadening of the EN Scope came later.
- Suzanne How do you define "General Nursing" function
- Definition of Nurse is in the ACC Act. To change Act has to go through Parliament
- Pam suggested to them other instruments our s o p are legal instruments.
- The treatment provider regulations are very political (like an insurance company)
- CNO challenge them
- ACC still deciding whether to make changes to ACC
- EN will be in ACC contract for Urgent Care, Rural providers, and GP practices.
- Employers can employ EN under this act
- Treatment providers all have different schedules, sometimes use this to determine if Nurse fits schedule.
- Take off "Second level Nurse" on NCNZ website.
