Bernadette Heapy, Advisor, Immunisation Advisory Centre, Central Region		Robyn welcomed and introduced Bernadette to the committee ? does the EN Scope of Practice sit in the immunization programme. Currently EN's are to be approved, but not authorized by the Ministry of Health in each region, which varies across New Zealand. 1984 – Medicines Act? Can EN be authorized vaccinators? Ask Jane Bodkin on 7 th August. Agreed by all that access, equity issue, poor vaccination rates, limited workforce. Medical officer of health can give orders for vaccination, not covered with indemnity insurance. Pharmacist vaccinators do this in their own right. Total of 4 vaccines. Chief Nurse of health does not support anyone but authorized vaccinators. Standard orders cover everyone. Currently ENs can do training but not be authorized vaccinators. Get medical officers in each region on board = so we can see if vaccination fits within EN
