CANTERBURY REGIONAL ENROLLED NURSE SECTION REMIT: 3. STRUCTURES OF NATIONAL COMMITTEE (a) Membership	CURRENT RULE IS: 2019 05 Rules of the Enrolled Nurse Section of NZNO 3. STRUCTURES OF NATIONAL COMMITTEE (a) Membership (i) Enrolled Nurse Section NZNO National committee shall consist of no more than seven (7) elected members with a wide geographical representation, with no more than two (2) elected members from the same regional section which includes the elected Chairperson if from that region, plus one (1) Te Runanga representative. PROPOSED RULE CHANGE TO REMOVE: With no more than two (2) elected members from the same regional section, which includes the elected Chairperson if from that region. RATIONALE: The rationale for this rule change is by omitting the part of the rule (With no more than two (2) elected members from the same regional section, which includes the elected Chairperson if from that region) is, even if a region already has 2 members on committee, but there are unfilled vacancies on the committee, then those vacancies should be opened to whoever is interested. It would be great to have a wide geographical mix on the committee, but if there is no support from other regions, best to have a full committee. The committee is there for all EN's, not their own region. Also, if a committee member moves to another region, they should still be allowed to stay on committee for their term.
