NATIONAL CAMPAIGN

#wecantwait campaign with CCNZ

- Many will remember that a petition with 30,000 signatures was submitted to parliament as part of this campaign in Dec 2021.
- CCNZ was approached and requested to be part of a Petition Committee meeting (zoom), on 21st of October 2021. This meeting was attended by Richard Stein (chair of CCNZ), Prof Richard Gearry, Marian O'Connor (NZIBDNG & NZgNC representative) and Zoe Raos (NZSG President). The group were allocated a meeting time of 10 minutes to highlight the campaign and the reality of our patients living with Crohn's and colitis when the current available biologic therapies (Anti-TNF) cease to work. Overall the sentiment was that our commitment to patient care and need for further medications was heard and we are awaiting the outcome
- Publication in JCC the committee have highlighted the lack of funding for medications internationally with a publication in JCC (see attached for reference paper). This was also sent to Pharmac to continue the momentum of this campaign.
