I received it prior to commencing my nine week placement. I was able to budget the money to spread across a two month span to pay for my rent and travel to and from placement for two months. Spending approximately \$375 each week. This scholarship helped me and my husband who is also in his third year of nursing training. It assisted us in a time where we could reduce the amount of hours in part time employment to focus on our placements, psychologically, spiritually and physically. The scholarship adds mana to what we are trying to do as nurses. Enabling us to develop ourselves together professionally. With reduced hours of work we were able to have the rest required for good concentration in practice.

We were able to further develop our evidence based research to improve the way we work in practice, during placement as we had time with the reduced work hours.

We also spent four days in practice with the year ones as preceptors under the direction and delegation of our tutors to grow our leadership, which was educational and inspirational.
