	Highlighted an issues when applying for funding from ANIVA, they are	
	declined. How can the PNS advocate for them to get funding to pay for	
	their studies? Concerns raised – there are students who are not eligible	
	to apply through the ACE system for potential jobs after graduating.	
	Students are only eligible for ACE if they have been a permanent NZ	
	resident for at least 2 years. Nurses who have received residency but are	
	students in the GradDip course cannot apply through ACE.	
	There is a need for more information about ACE for students to inform	
	them about that programme and application process.	
	There are barriers in the system when students apply for the GradDip	
	programme where they are not eligible for funding yet other	
	undergraduate and post graduate programmes are eligible for funding.	
	Response from Chair – PNS can advocate for students in the programme	
	and help look for other sources of funding.
