

Definitive Perioperative Nurses Trauma Care Course

The Definitive Perioperative Nurses Trauma Care (DPNTC) course is a three day training program for instrument nurses, anaesthetic nurses and anaesthetic technicians who have a minimum of two years recent clinical experience in a perioperative setting.

The DPNTC course is the preeminent trauma surgery course in Australasia and the only course that runs conjointly with surgeons (Definitive Surgical Trauma Care), and anaesthetists (Definitive Anaesthetic Trauma Care).

This course aims to foster teamwork and collaboration in the interdisciplinary care of the surgical trauma patient. The theory components of the program and hands-on operative laboratory will give you increased confidence in dealing with challenging trauma situations.

The course is a unique opportunity for perioperative nurses to train together and focus on surgical decision-making and operative techniques in the care of critically ill trauma patients.
