This award is to enable PNC to acknowledge the contribution of individual members to the work of the college at a national level.

CRITERIA.

The nominee must be a current or past PNC member who has/ had a commitment to PNC and who has made a superior contribution to the national work of PNC

Contribution could be made in any area of PNC activities at a national and/or international level

- promotion of PNC to nurses
- National committee work
- performed additional work for the committee

NOMINATIONS

- A. Prospective recipients can be nominated by:
- Regions
- Individual members
- National committee
- B. The nominator submits
- Biographical synopsis
- Description of contribution
- C. Process for the nominating members for awards:
- Nominations can be made at any time. Closing dates for the year will be one week before the mid-year meeting of the National Committee.
- Nominations for the awards are to be forwarded to national secretary PNC, who will then pass on applications to national committee.
- A person can be nominated more than once and by more than one group or individual.
- Approval of the person being nominated does not have to be sought by the nominee
- National committee decides annually on the awards.

PRESENTATION

National recognition of the service and paid membership and journal subscription to be presented at AGM of PNC
