Kim's involvement in the Colorectal Service has evolved over the last 15 years, initially starting as an Endoscopy Nurse, including several years as the Stoma Nurse. In 2012 Kim was part of the team to successfully implement the ERAS (Enhanced Recovery after Surgery) pathway into the Southern DHB throughout the Southland and Otago region and has been in the role of Colorectal Clinical Nurse Specialist for 8 years. A large part of her role is co-ordinating the patient cancer pathway from Diagnosis to 5th year of surveillance. In 2020 Kim won the Southern DHB Award for Care and Compassion.
