The presentation will highlight the importance of incorporating Te Tiriti o Waitangi, specifically Kāwanatanga, Tino Rangatiratanga, Ōritetanga, and Wairuatanga, to promote cultural competence. Furthermore, Dean will outline the necessity for healthcare professionals to grasp the practical components of Te Ao Māori & Tikanga throughout the perioperative patient journey, ensuring a holistic and culturally sensitive approach to healthcare delivery.
