Ian qualified as an Anaesthetic Technician (ODP) in the UK in 1987 before moving to New Zealand and starting work at North Shore Hospital in 2005. Ian's involvement with Operation Restore Hope began in 2006 when he heard about the transformative impact of the charity from a colleague who had participated in a mission the previous year. Ian was intrigued by the organisation's commitment to surgically repairing cleft lips, palates and facial disfigurement for underprivileged children and he decided to contribute his skills and time to the cause and has been actively involved since. Missions are conducted primarily in Manila but do extend their reach to other areas, including Vietnam and Bangladesh.

In this presentation Ian will discuss his time in these areas with Operation Restore Hope. The teams not only perform surgeries but also educate and enhance the skills of local medical staff, leaving a lasting impact on both the individuals treated and the communities served.
