
Q1 What area of practice do you currently work in?






Q2 What NZNO region do you current fall under?

Q3 What describes your role best?





Q4 How long have you been practicing within a Primary Health Care setting?





Q5 What is your Age?





Q6 What is your preference to the structure of the education sessions provided by the NZ College of PHC Nurses? (tick all that are relevant)





Q7 How much are you prepared to pay for a 1 day symposium?





Q8 How much are you prepared to pay for a 2 day conference?





Q9 How much are you prepared to pay for a 2 to 4 hour regional event?




