




Growth driven by emerging destinations






Inbound Tourism; Purpose 2016




Inbound Tourism; Mode of Transport 2016
















Propensity for International Travel





BEWARE OF CROCODILES



Estuarine (Saltwater)
Crocodiles
are known in all water areas.
(River & Billabongs)
Attacks by these animals
can cause injury or death.



WARNING - Magpie territory

Magpies nest in this area and may swoop on intruders. This is normal defensive behaviour during the breeding season and lasts up to six weeks.

To protect yourself:

- Walk quickly through area don't run
- Wear a hat or carry an umbrella
- Bike riders dismount and walk
- Never deliberately provoke or harass a magpie as this usually makes them more defensive

The Magpie is a protected species under the Nature Conservation Act 1992.

In dangerous situations, a State Government, Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service Officer may authorise the removal of a particular bird.







Length of Absence




Peak/Seasonal Travel Patterns


December - January
