## Commentary on the College of Respiratory Nurses NZNO Financial Statements for the Year Ended 31 March 2021

## **Income and Expenditure**

Total income for the 2020/21 financial year was \$16,964 comprising National Office funding \$16,240, interest \$542, and some residual symposium income of \$183. Expenses totalled \$6,923, resulting in a net surplus of \$9,871 after tax of \$170.

Expenses in 2020/21 of \$6,923 comprised \$600 for sponsorship of the Asthma and Respiratory Foundation conference, \$300 for an audio production and Committee meeting and administration expenses of \$6,023.

The symposium planned for 2020 was cancelled due to the Covid19 pandemic.

## **Statement of Financial Position**

The College of Respiratory Nurses ended the financial year on 31 March 2021 with cash at bank (including term deposits) totalling \$72,955 compared to \$65,259 on 31 March 2020. The increase of \$7,696 in cash is a combination of the 2020/21 surplus for the year of \$9,871 and downward movements in other working capital items of \$2,175.
