*To secure for eligible people in need of pharmaceuticals, **the best health outcomes** that can reasonably be achieved and from within the amount of funding provided*







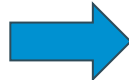

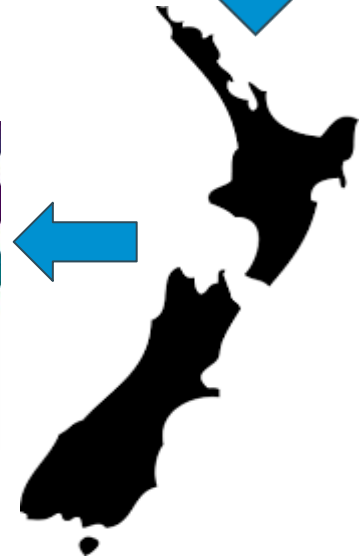

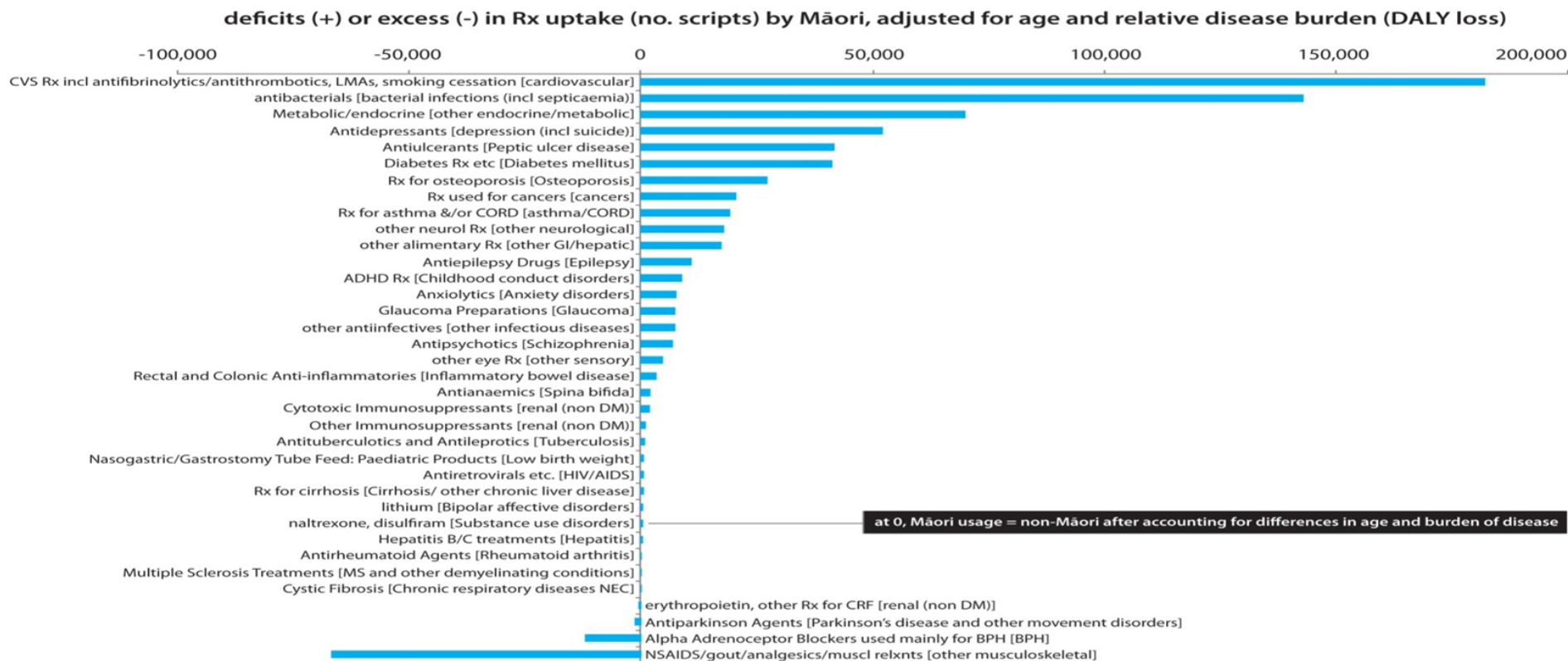

**Pou tuawha**- we support and are involved in research and development about Pharmaceutical management

**Pou tuarima**- we develop and enhance the matauranga Māori of the 120 staff at PHARMAC.

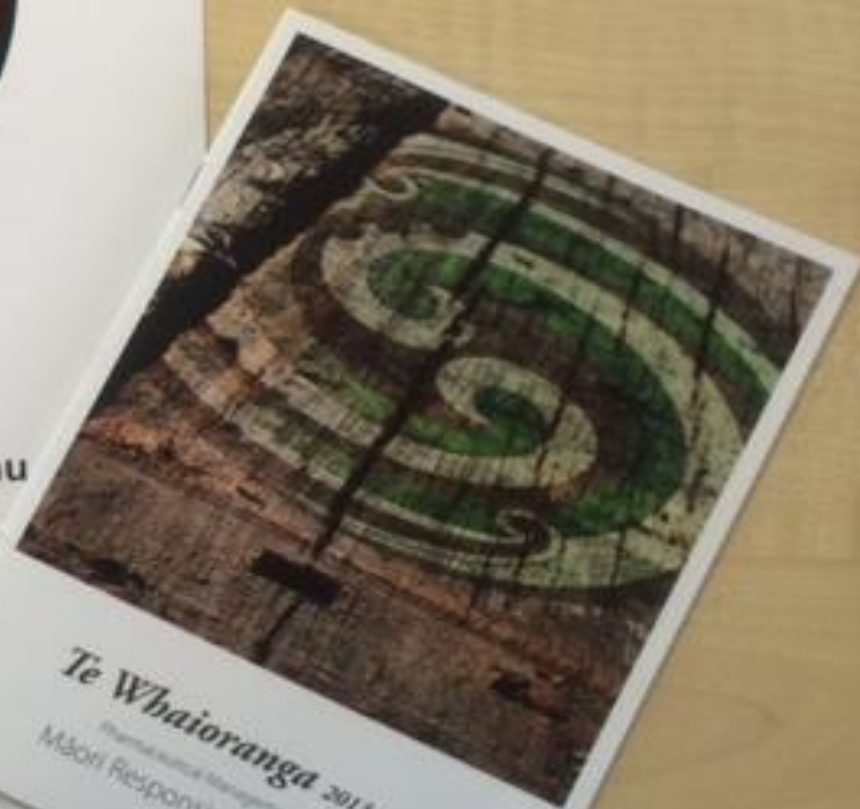
