PHARMAC?

PHARMAC is a crown agency of 120 staff-Wellington based

PHARMAC provides funded access to pharmaceuticals for all New Zealanders

To secure for eligible people in need of pharmaceuticals, <u>the best health outcomes</u> that can reasonably be achieved and from within the amount of funding provided

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Gaps in Māori use of Medicine - 2006/2007

After adjusting for age, burden of disease(need) and relevant to the Pharmaceutical Schedule



deficits (+) or excess (-) in Rx uptake (no. scripts) by Māori, adjusted for age and relative disease burden (DALY loss)
