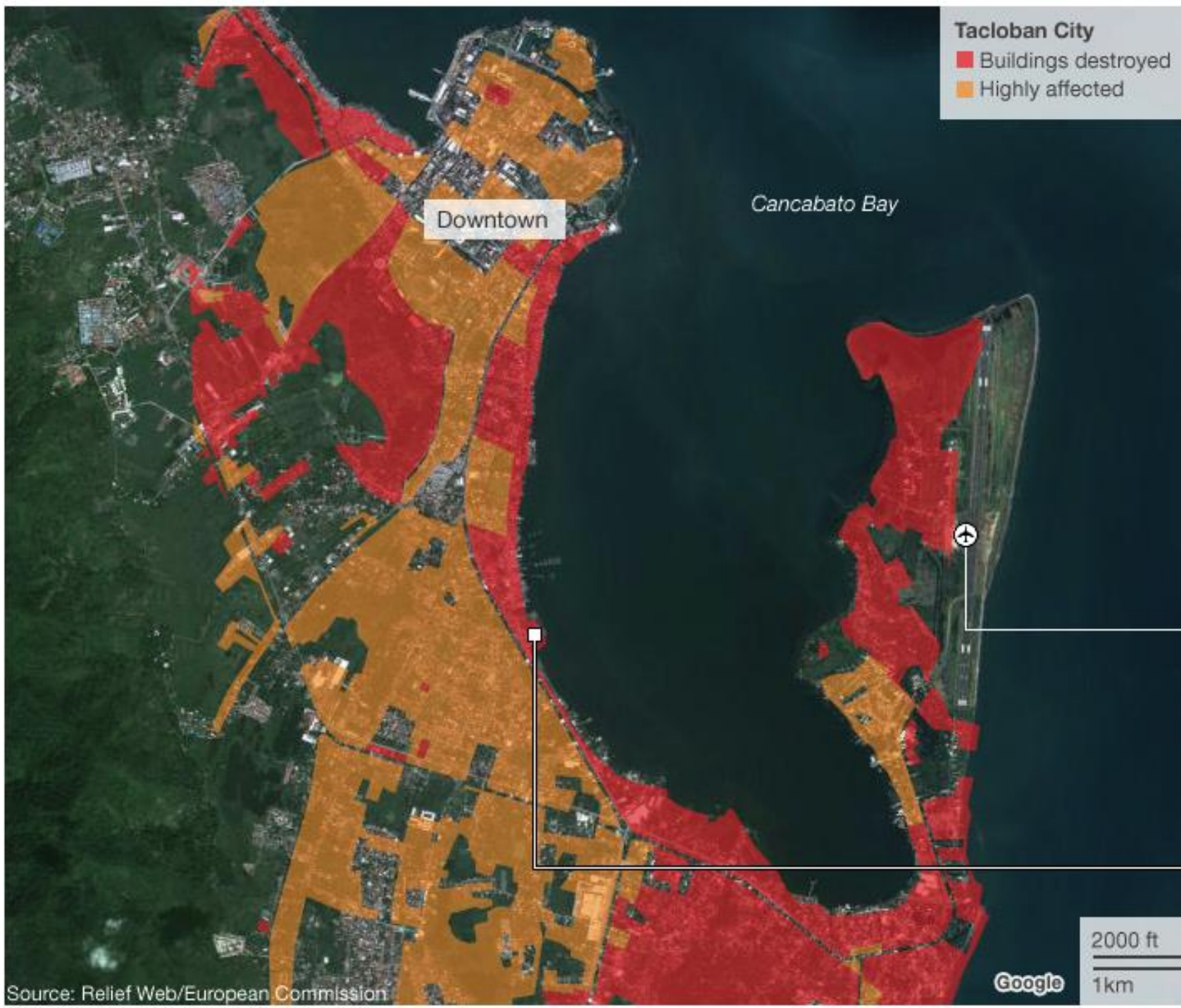


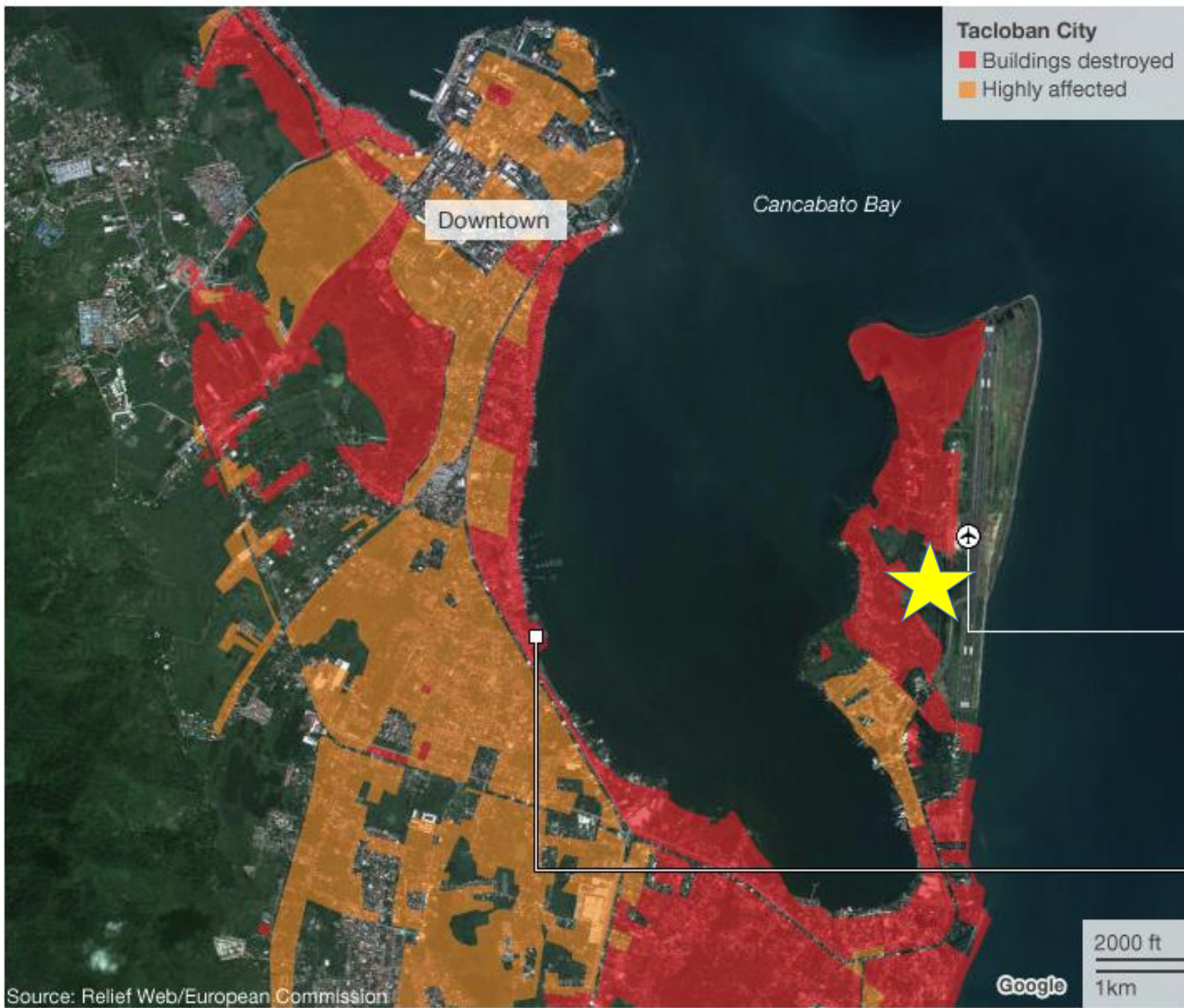


Typhoon Haiyan

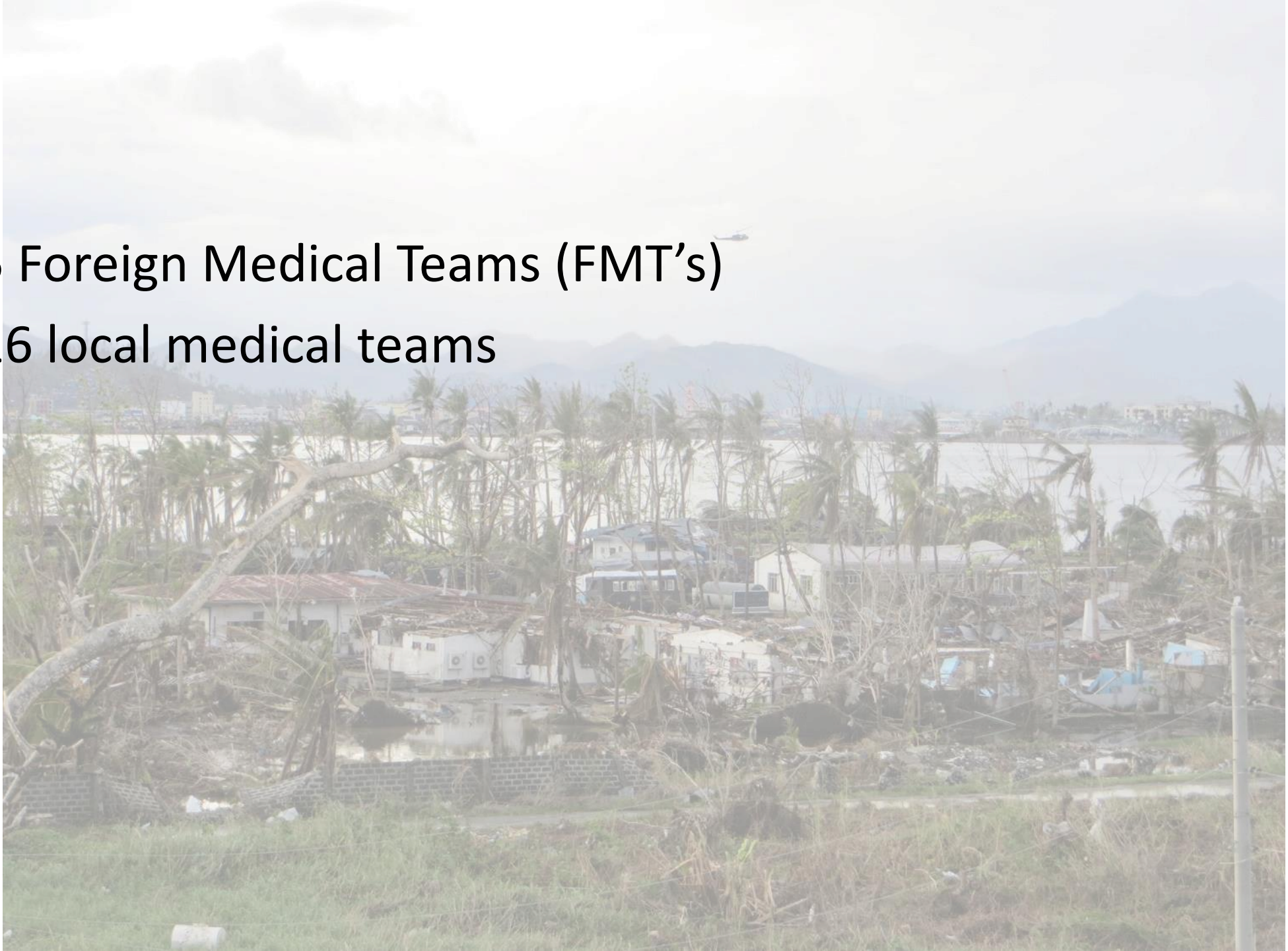
- >6300 dead

- 116 local medical teams

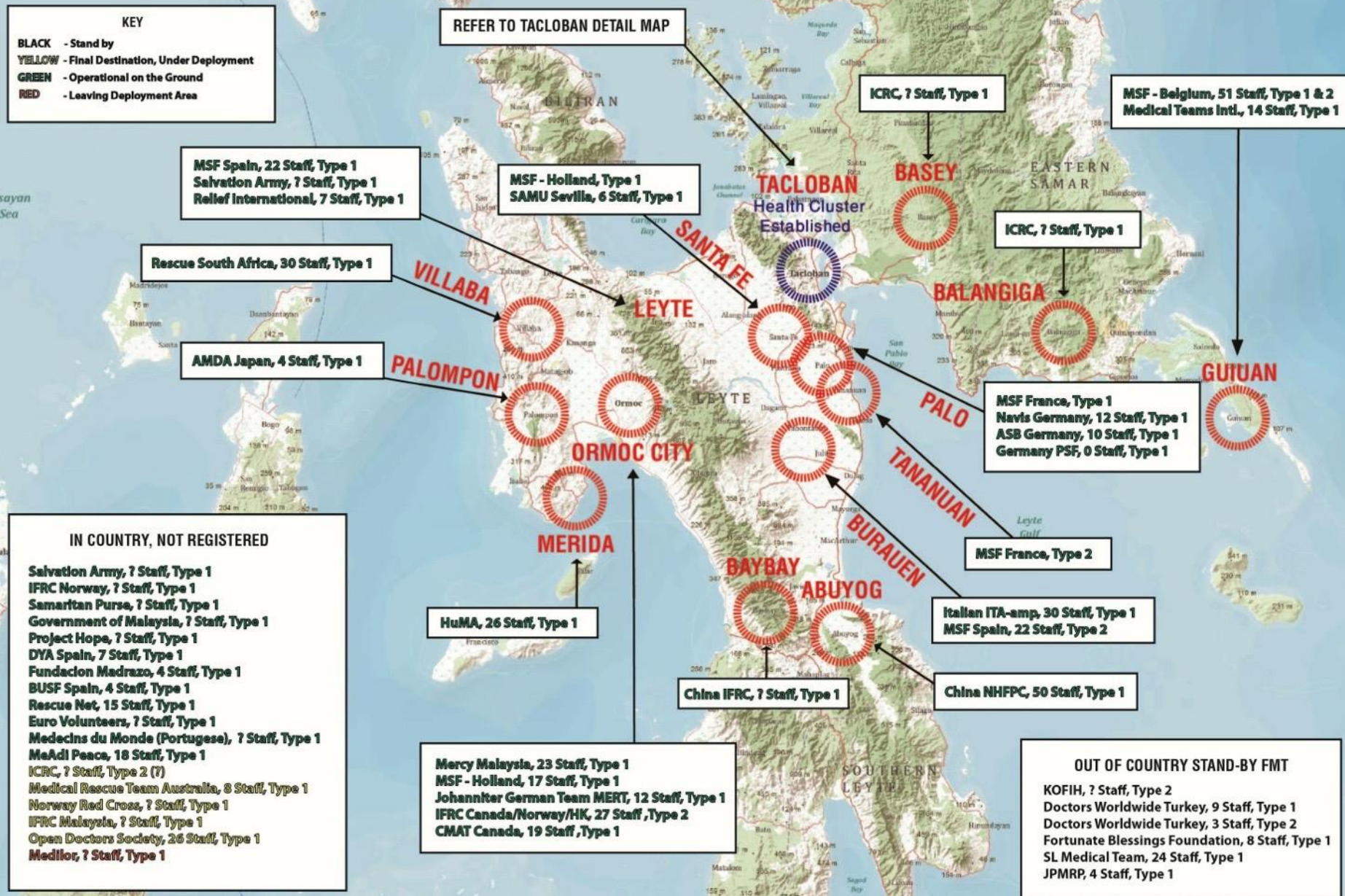


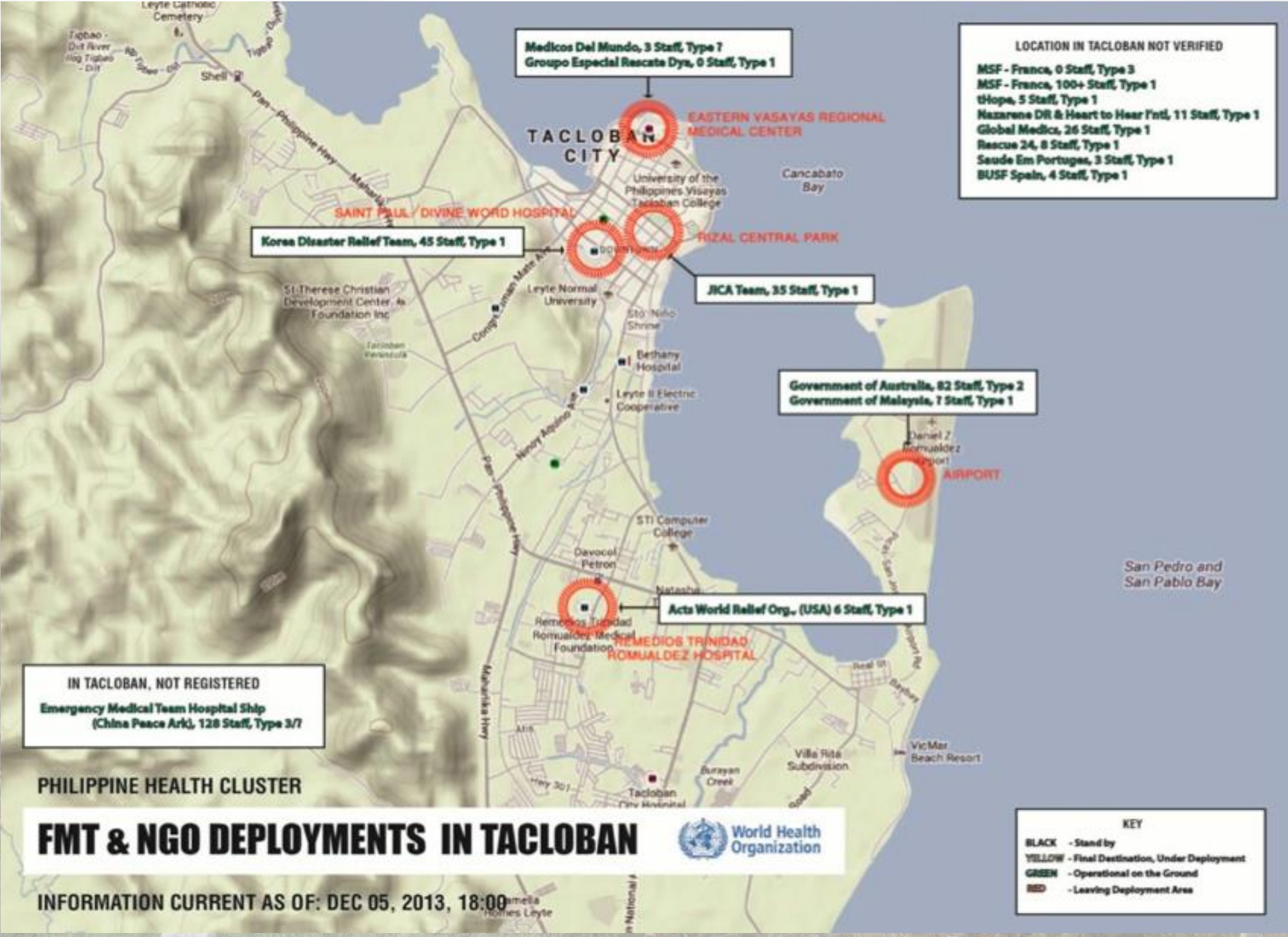
FOREIGN MEDICAL TEAMS (FMT) & NGOs IN RESPONSE TO TYPHOON YOLANDA

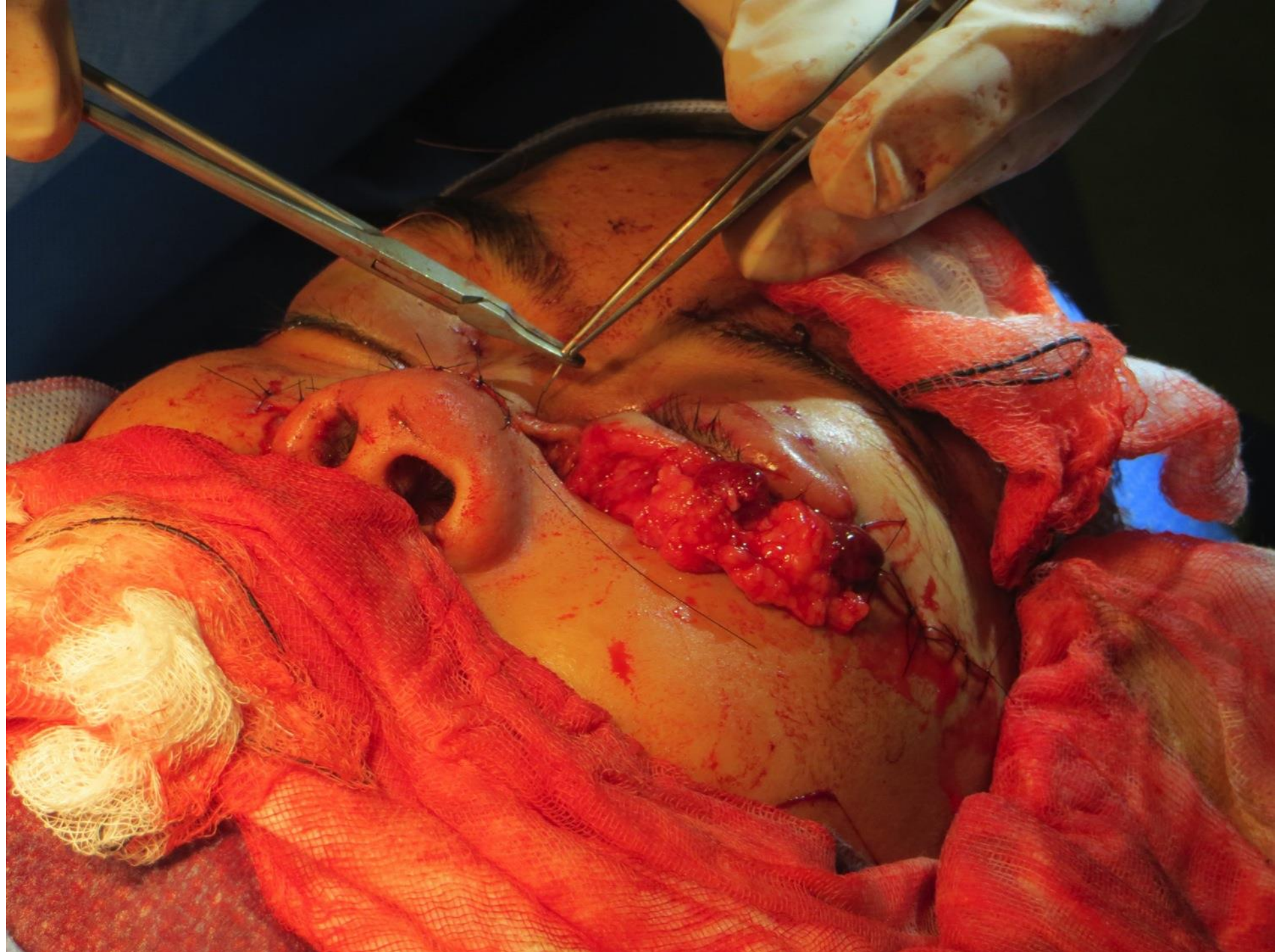

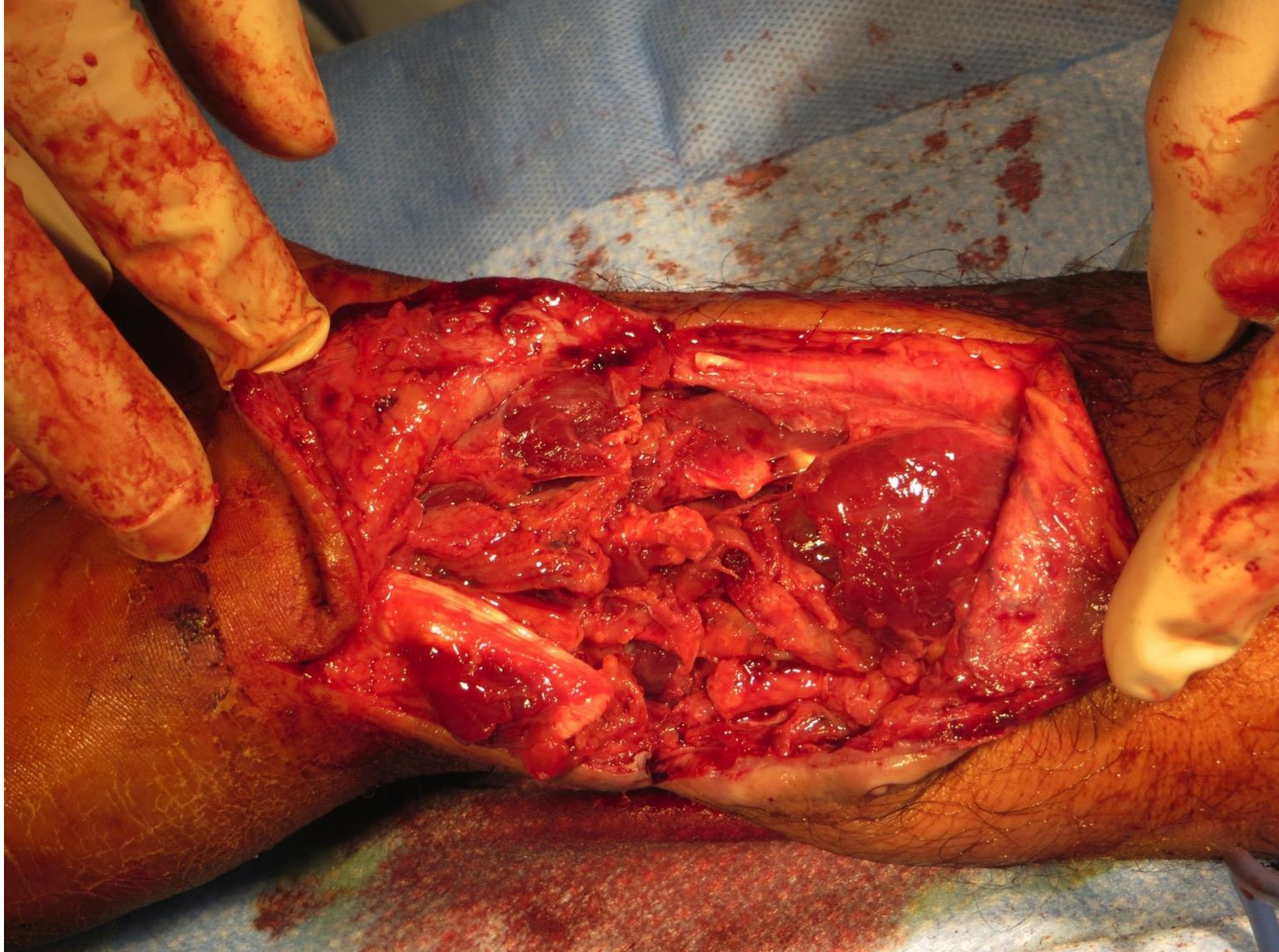

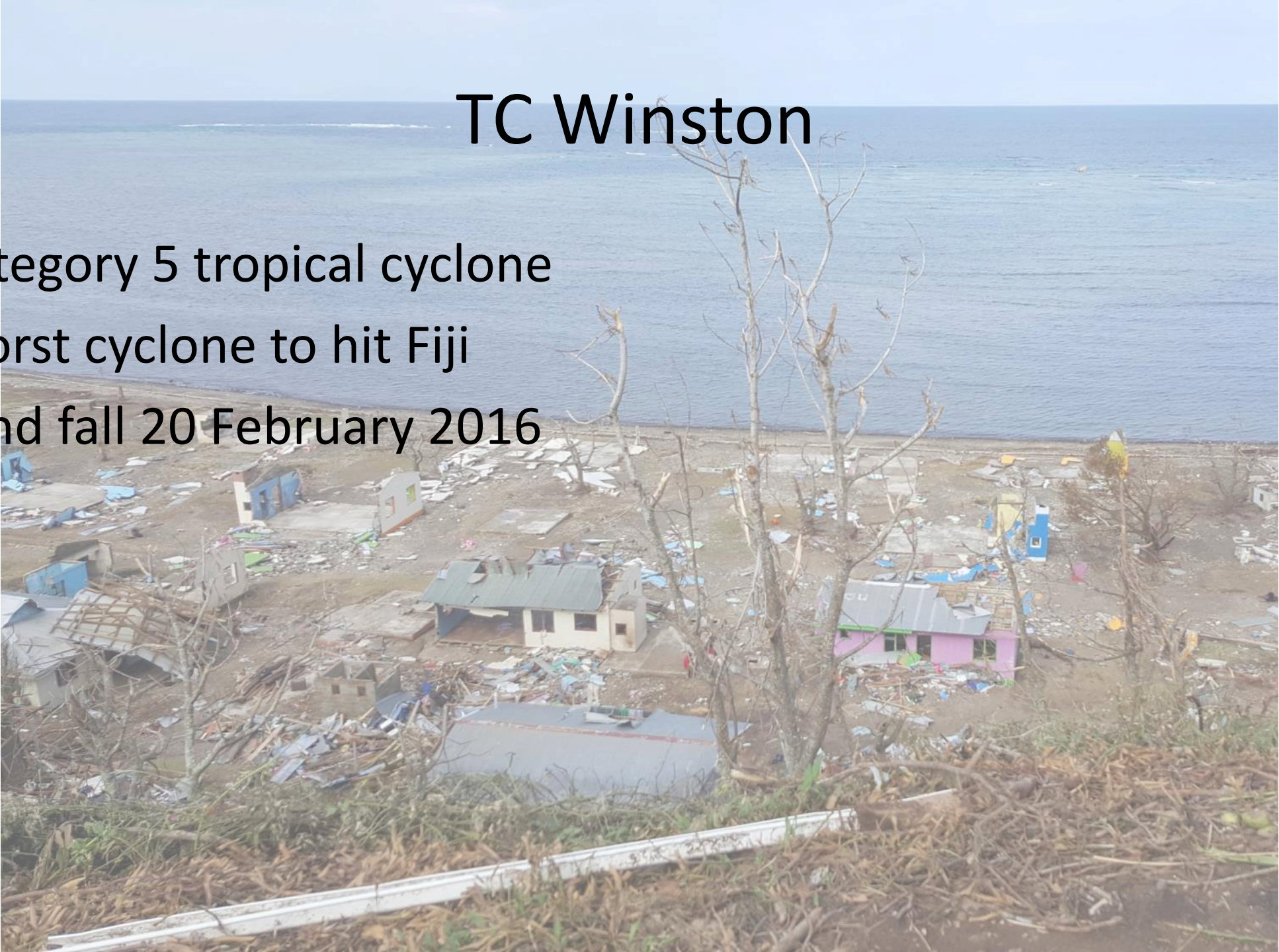

TC Winston

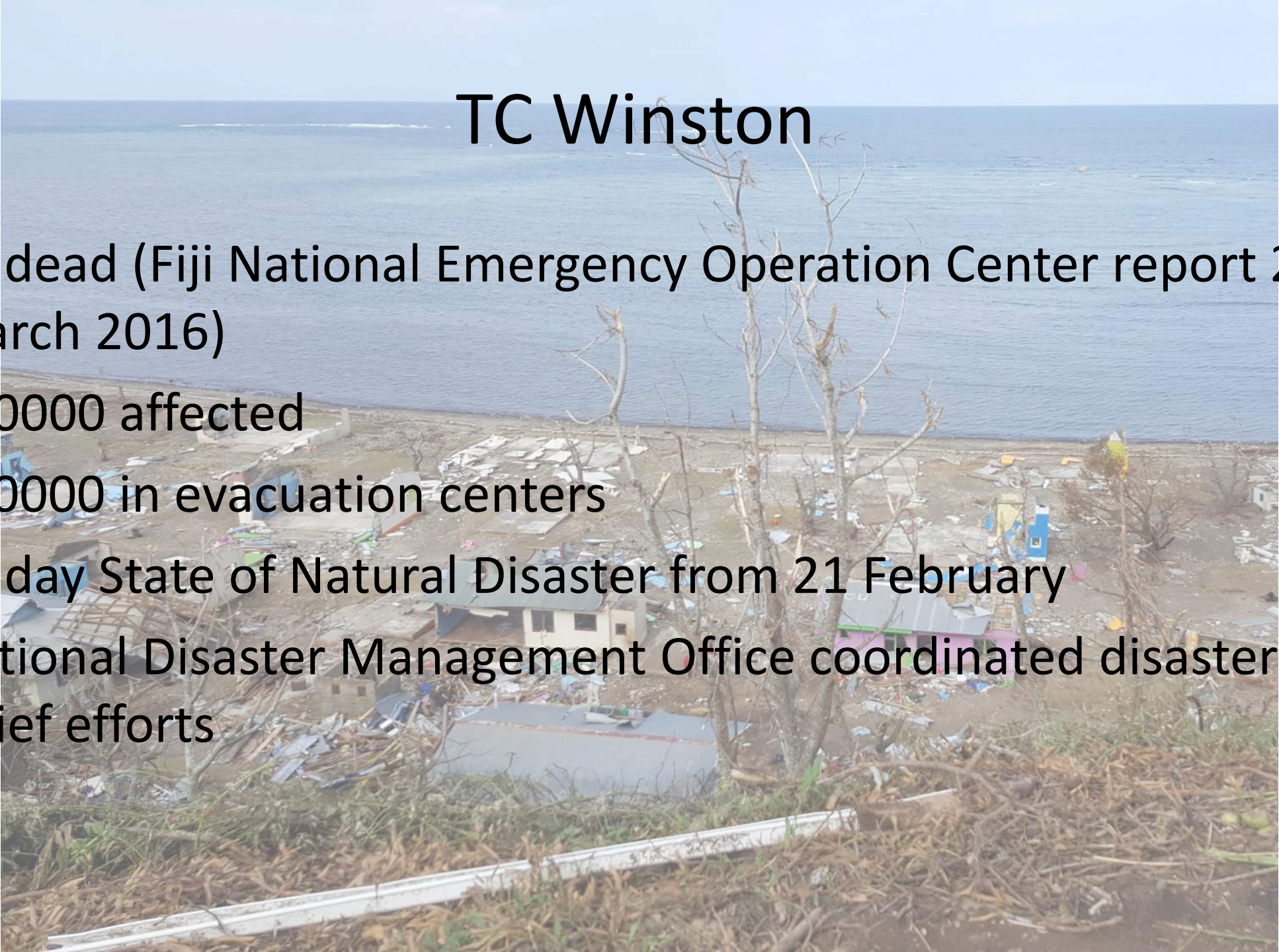
- Category 5 tropical cyclone

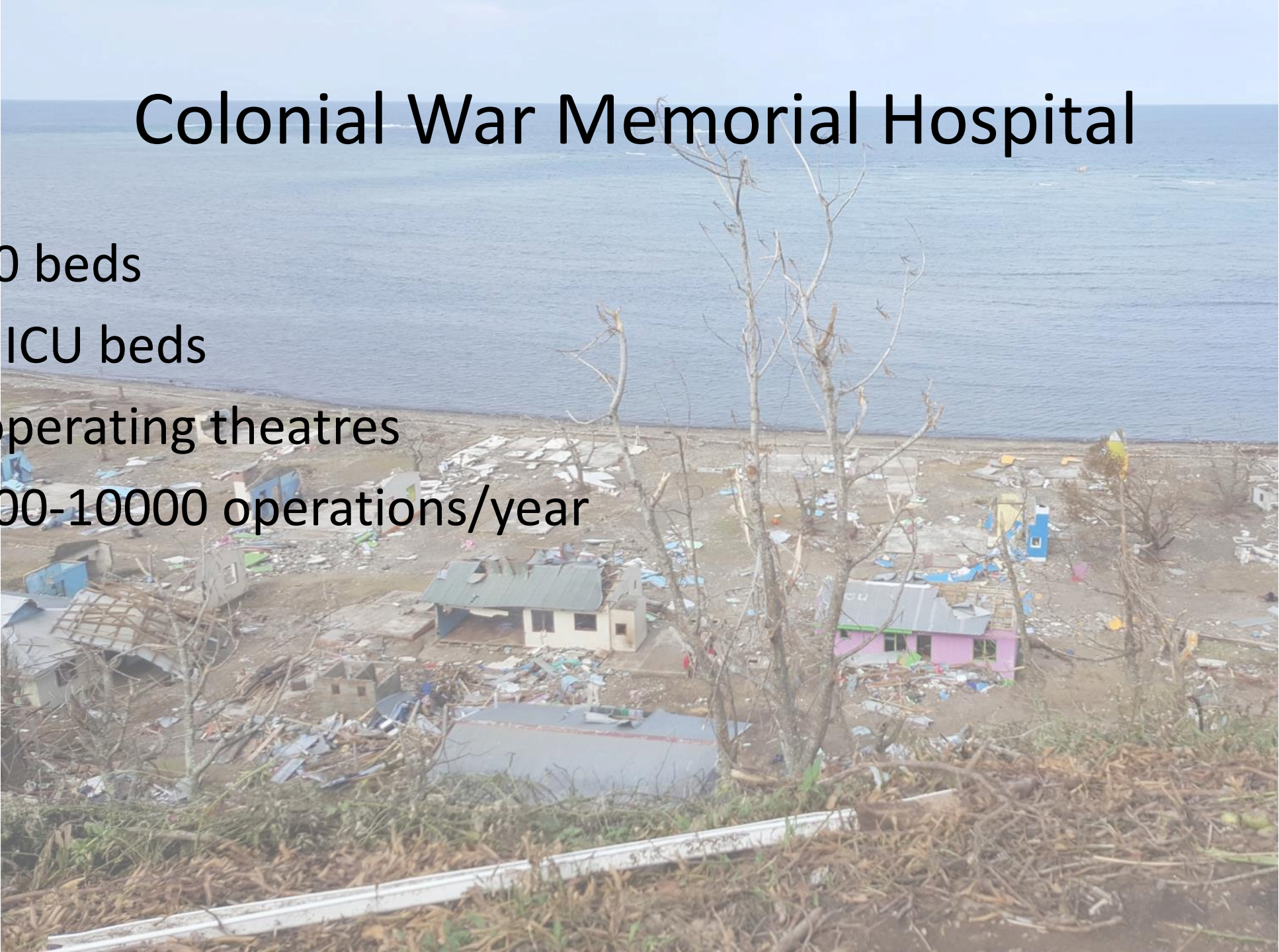
