Please indicate if this is your first time presenting a paper at any conference as there is a best first-time presenter award of \$250.

All abstracts should be submitted in the following format.

Title Presentation title

Authors
All authors are listed; presenters name underlined

Organisation Presenter's organisation listed

Contact details Presenter's postal address, e-mail address and phone number

Body of abstract can be in two styles:

- 1. Research abstract: Aim, Methods, Results, Conclusions
- 2. Opinion piece: Objective, Discussion, Conclusions

The abstract is to be limited to 250 words. The font should be 10 pt Times New Roman and single-spaced. All abstracts should be <u>submitted electronically</u> by e-mail (MS Word or rich text format).

Abstracts will only be accepted electronically.

All accepted papers will have their abstract and author profile published in the conference Programme booklet. Notification of the review committee's acceptance or non-acceptance of abstracts will be mailed to authors by the 28 March 2022.

All presenters must be registered for the conference.

Presenters will be allocated 10 minutes for their presentation with 5 minutes for questions. Presentations must be in PowerPoint and emailed to Jill Lamb. It is recommend also to have a backup on a memory stick to present to the sound technician.

Guidelines for Poster Presentations

The NZNO Women's Health Section conference committee invites health professionals to submit an abstract to present a poster at our annual conference to be held on the 26-28 May 2022

A prize of \$500 will be given for the best paper presented by a nurse on women's health issues

The abstract should include:

• Title Poster title

• Authors All authors listed, presenter underlined

Organisation Presenter's organisation listed

Contact details
Presenter's postal address, email address and phone number

Body of abstract can be in two styles:

Research abstract: Aim, Methods, Results, Conclusions

Opinion piece: Objective, Discussion, Conclusions

The abstract is to be limited to 250 words. The font should be 10 pt Tahoma and single-spaced.

All abstracts should be <u>submitted electronically</u> by e-mail and recommend back up on a USB (MS Word or rich text format). **Abstracts will only be accepted electronically.**

The maximum dimension of the poster should be 100 cm x 150 cm

All accepted posters will have their abstract and author profile published in the conference programme booklet.

Notification of the review committee's acceptance or non-acceptance of abstracts will be emailed to authors the 28 March 2022.

All presenters must be registered for the conference.

Closing date for abstracts 28 February 2022

You will not be expected to present your poster to the Conference delegates. However, you will be allocated a time where you will be expected to be at your poster to answer any questions.
