DEBBIE BOOTH MEMORIAL TRAVEL AWARD **CRITERIA**

- Paper presenter must be a financial member of the Perioperative Nurses College
- Papers to be a maximum of 15 minutes duration and have a medical imaging nursing focus
- One entry per presenter only
- Minimum of 6 papers for award to be judged
- Same person cannot win in 2 consecutive years
- Employees of any medical supply company is excluded
- Winner is expected to submit an article for the Post Conference Issue of *The Dissector* based on the winning topic.
- Award is a travel grant, up to the value of \$1500 for educational purposes. (Traditionally the recipient was encouraged to present their winning paper at an appropriate Australian Medical Imaging Association meeting the following year, however this is not compulsory).
- Runner Up Award is up to the value of \$500.00
- The free paper presentations will be held on the Thursday afternoon of conference
- The award will be announced and presented during the Annual General Meeting of PNC

Note: The winner will not receive the \$200 publishing incentive of *The Dissector* as per the exclusion criteria (*The Dissector*, 2009, 37(3), p.8)

Three Judge Panel

- One Debbie Booth Award sponsor representative
- One Perioperative Nurses College National Committee member
- One Debbie Booth Runner Up Award sponsor representative

At the discretion of National Committee the judging panel may change based on sponsor availability. At least one college National Committee member will be on the judging panel.
