Purpose

The purpose of this award is to encourage and support the advancement of professional development of nurses working the perioperative environment.

Eligibility

Financial members of the NZNO Perioperative Nurses College.

Criteria

This award is available to members who are enrolled in postgraduate study with a perioperative focus. Up to \$1000.

Evidence

Evidence of enrolment in study programme and papers completed towards the postgraduate qualification.

And the following:

1. A description of the speciality area the nurse works
2. Using 'reflective writing' submit a 500 word narrative of how post graduate study has made a difference to their perioperative practice
3. Acknowledgement of other financial support already gained

The successful applicant will be required to write an article for *The Dissector* at the completion of the paper. This can take the format of a case-study, literature review and/or issue in practice that is evidence-based and will be made available within four (4) months of completion of the paper.

Exclusions

Applicants who have previously received this award in the past two years.
